Uniforms

During summer band camp each student will be fitted with a band or color guard uniform.

These band uniforms are property of the Centennial School District and the color guard uniforms are the property of the WTMBA. Each member is responsible for any damage to or loss of uniform articles.

To ensure uniformity, there are parts of the uniform that each student is required to have and receive through the WTMBA. Sets are provided as part of the annual Activity Fee, but if the student requires additional pieces throughout the year, the Uniform committee will make them available for purchase.

Cleaning of the band uniforms (bibbers, jackets, overcoats) will be handled by the uniform committee. However, if you eat something and accidentally spill something on your uniform, get to a uniform representative quickly!

All Color Guard uniforms are to be hand washed, separately, as needed, following manufacturer instructions.

Each student will be handed a set of Uniform Care Instructions and Inspection Expectations at Uniform Distribution. Please take the time to become familiar with them. Each piece has its own requirements.
