We are pleased to announce that the 30th Annual Celebration of Bands (COB) will be held on Saturday evening, September 19, 2026. Marching bands from the surrounding area visit William Tennent to perform at our stadium. Each band is rated by a panel of judges and receives an award based on their performance.

This is the largest fundraiser for our Marching Band. We raise money at COB through the sale of entrance tickets, novelties, refreshments and program book ads. The majority of the money is raised through the sale of ads for our program book.

Volunteering:

- At least one parent or guardian is requested to volunteer at the Celebration of Bands show on Saturday, September 19, 2026
- This will involve volunteering for the duration of the COB event, AND your choice of working either the morning set up or evening clean-up.
- Both parents or guardians are requested to volunteer if there are two students in the marching band from the same family.

Selling Ads:

- **Students are requested to sell ads for the program book.** This is the fastest way to increase your student account, which can be used to pay for the varying costs associated with marching band (i.e. trips, dues, etc.).
- **10% (with a cap of \$100) of total ad sales per student will go toward the Music Boosters General Account.** All remaining money from ad sales will go directly into your students account to be used at your discretion for defined band-related fees.
 - For example, if a student sells \$200 in ads, \$20 will go towards the general fund and \$180 will be deposited into the student account.
- All other profit from ticket sales, ad book sales, novelty sales, concessions, etc. will be directly deposited into the WT MBA general fund.

Getting ads is not difficult! Ask your dentist, doctor, hair stylist, bank, grocery store, florist, restaurant, or any other business that you frequent. Everyone should be able to sell a minimum of \$100 in ads.

Remember, the more ads you sell, the more money for your student account!

This packet includes a “**Dear Supporter**” Letter and **Ad Form** for you to give to those businesses that you are soliciting. Please make additional copies of these forms and leave them in your car to contact businesses as you are doing everyday errands. We can also provide

you with a copy of the program book from the previous COB to use as a selling tool for prospective advertisers.

NEW this year is a digital form for Ads that you can share!

The **Bought Ad in Past List** can be used as a reference to reach out to companies that previously supported our marching band. You will notice on the list there may be a student's name next to a company, please ask that student if they intend on soliciting this year before reaching out. If they are not, those companies are free to solicit.

After you receive an ad from an advertiser, please complete the attached “**Thank You for Your Support**” **Form** to provide them with a receipt and invitation to attend.

All ads, forms and payments must be submitted by **August 31st 2026** in order to allow sufficient time to produce the program book.

Advertisers can submit ads by: Emailing submissions directly to cobprogrambook@gmail.com or by scanning the QR Code for google form submissions.

We are also providing a separate QR Code for **Well-Wisher Forms** via google forms. We are asking for this to be the primary method of submission if possible to ensure ease and accuracy.

We highly encourage ads to be submitted digitally as ad quality is compromised when printed or scanned.

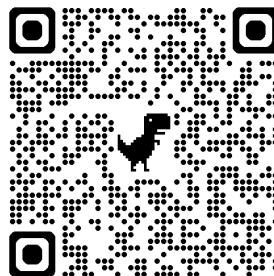

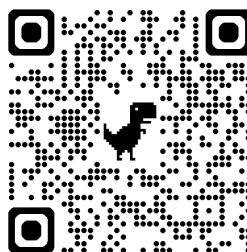
